

Senior SharePoint Developer

The Senior SharePoint Developer will be responsible for architecting, developing, deploying and supporting custom-built applications utilizing Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007 and other third-party products. This position will be responsible for supporting our SharePoint Solution Business Unit; understanding customer's business model and using technology to create solutions that meet their business needs.

Job Responsibilities:

- Design, coding, implementation, testing, administration and maintenance of SharePoint (MOSS 2007) sites
- Custom application development in support of large collaboration/installation projects utilizing SharePoint (MOSS 2007) technologies
- Design, develop and maintain custom components for web-based, content management products that enable seamless functionality between SharePoint Portal Server 2003/2007 (MOSS 2007) and MS Office
- Ability to plan, prioritize, and organize their work schedule to maximize performance with little or no supervision
- Work with Business Analysts to design & develop functionalities that meet business requirements
- Architect, design, develop, and implement web-enabled applications using .Net, C#, VB.Net and other Microsoft based technologies.
- Use judgment and creativity to design coding approach to meet requirements/specifications as provided by business analysts and project managers.
- Maintain current industry knowledge of development concept, practices and procedures.
- Responsible for estimating, creating, and meeting the timeline of the development of release.
- Work with end users to collect, analyze and evaluate business requirements.
- Examine requirements documents and create technical design documents, unit test, system test, user acceptance test, and implementation plans for small to complex projects.
- Provide production support for assigned systems.
- Perform quality assurance duties as requested. Test software to ensure proper operation and freedom from defects. Create and execute test plans.
- Provide technical guidance to the team in the technologies indicated in the mandatory knowledge and abilities section.
- Assist in the resolution of program performance issues.
- Create custom workflow-based solutions to help the business operate more effectively and efficiently
